Oxford University Press is a department of the University of Oxford, and is the largest university press in the world. It publishes in many countries in a variety of different languages and across virtually the whole range of academic and educational disciplines.

The Project

Much of the group's work is centred on the latest in digital media technology and the new environment needed to house an Audio Visual editing post production facility and services that require the latest in communication technology.

The offices were designed to cope with bandwidth-intensive applications up to 100mb over a sophisticated voice over IP network and a dedicated project meeting room offers interactive whiteboard technology enabling the collaborative use of electronic documents and multimedia materials via computer.

With digital technology planning such a big part in the direction of the company, they were keen to work with partners who could design and furnish the office space to match the contemporary and high-tech feel offices.
