Case Study

Telefónica is an international telecoms company covering brands such as O2. Their head office in Slough needed an area re-purposed as it had become redundant over time within the building, having previously been used for printing equipment, as well as staff storage, including lockers and coat areas.

Brief

We were tasked with converting the space into a new agile area for informal meetings and a touchdown space for visiting workers, as well as specifying and supplying appropriate furniture.

The Project

To transform the area, we removed all the existing partitioning, along with the ceiling grid and flooring and installed new half-height walls with an Oak Veneer slat detail.

This provides visual interest, and a boundary to the area as a whole with the slats extended over the ceiling as a design detail.



The existing on-site colour scheme influenced the colours, and we used furniture from Boss Design to complement the aesthetics of the area. The slats and high bench were provided by Edward Williams and the flooring by Forbo.
